The success of the ISF Class of 2025 reflects the strength of this environment. Through dedication, strong academic preparation, and the support of their teachers and families, our graduates have achieved outstanding results in external examinations and secured offers from leading universities around the world.



EXTERNAL EXAM RESULTS

In 2025, 91% of ISF students who sat for IGCSE exams achieved grades A–C*, reflecting the strong academic foundations developed within our supportive international learning community.

On the International Baccalaureate (IB), the Class of 2025 achieved an average IB Diploma score of 34, with a highest score of 44 and a lowest score of 24 among 56 diploma candidates. Additionally, 60% of students earned a bilingual diploma, compared to approximately 31% worldwide—a remarkable achievement that highlights ISF's commitment to multilingual learning in a truly global school environment.

We are also pleased that 100% of ISF students pursuing Abitur equivalence through the IB successfully earned it, and 31% of IBDP results converted to an Abitur score of 1.9 or higher, opening doors to leading universities in Germany and around the world.

These results reflect not only academic achievement but also the confidence, adaptability, and global perspective that students develop while learning and growing together at ISF.

UNIVERSITY ACCEPTANCES

- Thanks to their strong academic preparation and the guidance of dedicated teachers and university counselors, the 68 students in the Class of 2025 received a total of 151 university offers from 94 universities across 14 countries.
- Notably, more than 60% of these acceptances came from universities ranked among the Top 200 globally according to the Times Higher Education World University Rankings 2025.
- Among the universities where ISF students received the most offers, 18 of the top 20 are ranked among the best in the world – a pattern that has remained consistent over the past 15 years. This remarkable outcome reflects not only academic excellence but also the global readiness and confidence that students develop as part of the ISF community.
- We warmly congratulate the Class of 2025 for their outstanding achievements and thank our dedicated teachers and supportive families for helping make this success possible.
