ISF International School Frankfurt Rhein-Main is seeking committed and motivated part-time coaches for its ISF Sports Academy. The aim of the ISF Sports Academy is to pursue the comprehensive physical, mental, social, and emotional growth of the student. With this aim in mind, ISF Sports Academy offers the following sports: Track and Field, Swimming, Badminton, Basketball, Volleyball, Football and Tennis. In addition to the sports mentioned, any other sports offer that may be interesting for the Academy will be considered for its possible implementation.

The different sports offered are practiced two to three times a week, between 60 and 90 minutes per training session depending on the sport. Due to the Sports Academy's participation in the German International School Tournaments (GISST), each sport enjoys three consecutive days of competition, in addition to some friendly matches during the school year.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

- Hold a valid work permit for Germany (mandatory)
- Possess previous experience in coaching.
- Have proper working knowledge of the English language as it is the language of instruction (German or Korean language skills are also an asset).
- Possess a wide variety of group management skills and strategies.
- Have a passion for sport, health and mental wellbeing.
- Possess the ability to meet professional obligations through efficient work habits.

KEY RESPONSABILITIES

- Develop a solid program for the sport considering the available space for practice, number of sessions, age and number of students, as well as their skill level in the sport.
- Develop each training session according to what is stipulated in the global program, establishing an objective for each training session and describing the activities to develop.
- Be responsible for the sports equipment used for the activity, returning it to its place when it is no longer in use.
- Take responsibility for the allocated sport group as a whole and each student individually, promoting both physical and sporting improvement, as well as human growth through the work of human values.
- Encourage the practice of reflection as a resource for learning.
- Adhere to the ISF Code of Conduct and Child Protection Policy.
- Inform the Athletics Director of any incident that occurs at any time during practice.
- Attend all scheduled training sessions and competitions and respect strictly their schedules.
- Know the rules and guidelines of the GISST competition of the sport, as well as the internal policies of the Sports Academy and the International School Frankfurt Rhein-Main.

OUR SCHOOL

The ISF International School Frankfurt Rhein-Main – founded by the City of Frankfurt, the State of Hesse, and multi-national corporations in September 1995 – offers world-class education from Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 12/13. We are an independent, co-educational, whole-day school situated in the heart of the Rhein-Main region of Germany offering non-sectarian, English language instruction.

Approximately 100 teachers and 50 administrative staff, the majority of whom are from the U.S., the U.K., and Germany, work at ISF. The school's German, French, Spanish, Korean, and Japanese teachers are all native speakers. Some teachers have been working at the school since it first opened in 1995.

ISF is a member of the SABIS® Network, an educational organization which manages schools in 16 countries on four continents. SABIS® Network schools are distinguished by their implementation of the SABIS® Educational System, a rigorous, internationally-oriented, college-preparatory system that has been developed over the past 130 years and emphasizes the core subjects of Mathematics, English, and world languages.

OUR CAMPUS

Besides complete academic facilities, the campus has exceptional outdoor and indoor sports facilities including a grass football pitch, complete track and field facilities, two tennis courts, a semi-Olympic indoor swimming pool and gymnasium. The two-story Library and a beautiful 400-seat Theatre complete this fine ISF campus.

OUR SCHOOL YEAR

The school year runs from the end of August through to the end of June. The 3 terms are between 12 and 13 weeks in length. The working week is Monday to Friday and the school day is 8.00am to 4.00pm. There are many after-school activities that are led by staff, parents and outside instructors. During the school year- between August and June - there are approximately 6 weeks of vacations; one week in October, two weeks for the Holiday Break, one Winter week in February and two weeks for the Spring Break. There are also the occasional German public holidays. In total, there are 180 school teaching days as well as two weeks of staff training and orientation before the start of the Academic year.

OUR CURRICULUM

ISF offers a traditional core college preparatory curriculum. A third language is studied starting in Grade 6. Students who complete their secondary education at ISF have the following options of diplomas and/or external exams:

- ISF High School Diploma (upon the satisfactory completion of the graduation requirements)
- IGCSE – The British International General Certificate of Secondary Education (at the end of Grade 10 or Grade 11)
- IB DP – The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (at the end of Grade 12 or Grade 13). ISF is an IB World School since August 2006.
- Advanced Placement – The American CollegeBoard Advanced Placement Exams (at the end of Grade 12)
