JOB DESCRIPTION

The PE program is based on the OPHEA standards, which have been modified to meet the needs of our students and work with our facilities and schedule. At ISF, swimming is integrated into the PE program. Units in PE are considered core allowing students to both develop skills and understanding over time, and to be exposed to a wide variety of athletic activities/skills.

ISF seeks a Physical Education teacher with skill and experience teaching PE at the Primary School level. The successful candidate for this position is an excellent teacher, a team player, a positive collaborator, uses technology appropriately, is student-centered and ignites students' interest in PE through their passion and their engaging and up to date pedagogy. The ability and desire to coach various team sports as part of the extensive co-curricular program at ISF is essential.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Teach PE classes up to 33 teaching hours per week, split between PE and swimming.
- Lead or assist in conducting extra-curricular sports up to 4 hours per week and or academic classes/study halls, some of which may take place after school or on weekends.
- Prepare objectives and outlines for courses of study, following curriculum guidelines and requirements of the school.
- Plan lessons, units and projects with clear objectives, and which help students understand and achieve those objectives

IDEAL REQUIREMENTS

- Two or more years of full-time, full-year experience in PE instruction
- Academic background or experience in the subject; degree in education
- English Native Speaker (German or Korean language skills are also an asset)
- Certification or enrollment in a certification program in area to be taught
- Dedication to being a reflective practitioner
- Possess a wide variety of class management skills and strategies
- Proficient technology skills, ability to integrate technology in the classroom
- Collegial and cooperative relationships with colleagues
- Ability to meet professional obligations through efficient work habits
- High energy and excellent health

OUR SCHOOL

The ISF International School Frankfurt Rhein-Main – founded by the City of Frankfurt, the State of Hesse, and multi-national corporations in September 1995 – offers world-class education from Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 12/13. We are an independent, co-educational, whole-day school situated in the heart of the Rhein-Main region of Germany offering non-sectarian, English language instruction.

Approximately 100 teachers and 50 administrative staff, the majority of whom are from the U.S., the U.K., and Germany, work at ISF. The school's German, French, Spanish, Korean, and Japanese teachers are all native speakers. Some teachers have been working at the school since it first opened in 1995.

ISF is a member of the SABIS® Network, an educational organization which manages schools in 16 countries on four continents. OUR CAMPUS

Besides complete academic facilities, the campus has exceptional outdoor and indoor sports facilities including a grass football pitch, complete track and field facilities, two tennis courts, a semi-Olympic indoor swimming pool and gymnasium. The two-story Library and a beautiful 400-seat Theatre complete this fine ISF campus.

OUR SCHOOL YEAR

The school year runs from the end of August through to the end of June. The 3 terms are between 12 and 13 weeks in length. The working week is Monday to Friday and the school day is 8.00am to 4.00pm. There are many after-school activities that are led by staff, parents and outside instructors. During the school year- between August and June - there are approximately 6 weeks of vacations; one week in October, two weeks for the Holiday Break, one Winter week in February and two weeks for the Spring Break. There are also the occasional German public holidays. In total there are 180 school teaching days as well as two weeks of staff training and orientation before the start of the Academic year.

OUR CURRICULUM

ISF offers a traditional core college preparatory curriculum. A third language is studied starting in Grade

6. Students who complete their secondary education at ISF have the following options of diplomas and/or external exams:

ISF High School Diploma (upon the satisfactory completion of the graduation requirements)

IGCSE – The British International General Certificate of Secondary Education (at the end of Grade 10 or Grade 11)

IB DP – The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (at the end of Grade 12 or Grade 13). ISF is an IB World School since August 2007.

Advanced Placement – The American Advanced Placement Exams (at the end of Grade 12)
