# GENERAL OVERVIEW



ISF was founded in 1995 by the city of Frankfurt, the State of Hesse, and multi-national corporations. It offers a world-class education from Kindergarten up to Grade 12. The state-of-the-art campus includes a theater, indoor, semi-Olympic sized swimming pool, tennis courts, a sports field with artificial turf, and a running track.

ISF students take weekly advising classes from Grades 4 through 9. to discuss contemporary themes. In addition, we have a Student Management Organization with counsellors, trained nurses on-campus, and several highly qualified university counsellors.

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

Students from Grades 1 to 8 are required to wear the ISF polo shirt to school and the P.E. shirt for sports. Students in Grade 9 & 10 are required to wear the P.E shirt for sports.

## SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to and from ISF is possible via a number of means. For those opting for public transport, two S-Bahn stops (S1 Sindlingen and S2 Zeilsheim) bring students within a short walk of the campus. A 'door-to-door' service is offered by private taxi companies and provides an alternative to public transportation.

## SCHOOL MEALS

The school caterer offers a nutritious hot meal service, including vegetarian options, at lunch time for all students. There is also a kiosk that offers snacks during breaks. Alternatively, students can opt to bring a packed lunch from home.



## ISF PARENT NETWORK

The ISF ParentNetwork (PN) plays a key role in helping ISF feel like home. They welcome new families, facilitate communication, and make our international community feel like a family.

Through the Parent Network, ISF parents:
