REGULAR ASSESSMENTS

In grades 1 to 4, students take monthly assessments in the core subjects to check that everyone is on track. In addition, starting in Grade 3, students take a multiple-choice test in Math and starting in Grade 4 English will be added on a weekly basis. If a student is falling behind, s/he is given academic support after school.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Students are encouraged to participate in extra-curricular activities and can choose from a wide range of options including crafts, music, chess and sports.

Korean students can enroll in Korean classes once a week. Music concerts take place twice a year for primary school students.
