Enjoy a cafeteria with many options. From delicious lunch and well-balanced snacks to a kiosk that you as a parent can also enjoy.

When it comes to school lunches, nothing is more important than freshness and variety. That's why serving freshly cooked meals – as recommended by the German Nutrition Society – goes without saying at ISF International School Frankfurt Rhein-Main **Verwaltungs-GmbH.**

Equally important: Sodexo, an international company currently operating in 80 countries with extensive catering experience, offers

students a choice of three meals each day in the ISF cafeteria. All meals are free of flavour enhancers and include organic ingredients as indicated on the menu. The choice includes:

- A vegetarian dish
- A dish without pork
- An international speciality

Also available daily: soup of the day, salads, desserts, fresh fruit, bread and water.



A GOOD SELECTION AT THE KIOSK

Sodexo runs a kiosk within the ISF cafeteria. Here students find tasty snacks, such as fresh fruit and juices, sandwiches, croissants, sweets and

ice cream. As a parent, you are also welcome to use the cafeteria during the following times: 08:00-09:00 and 15:00-17:00.

FAQS – GOOD TO KNOW

Your child will be well looked after - from the first day of school. You can either sign up for school lunches in advance by email or you can sign up in person on the first day of school. We are flexible!

WHAT DOES LUNCH COST EACH DAY?

The daily price is on a sliding scale. Kindergarteners pay €4.50, Grades 1-6 pay €4.50, and Grades 7-12 pay €5.00.

HOW ARE MEALS PAID FOR?

Your child can use his or her prepaid student card. Please ensure the card always has sufficient credit on it. Credit can be paid at the kiosk.

ARE MONTHLY MEAL PLANS AVAILABLE?

Yes. If you sign up your child, the following fees are deducted 10 times per school year: €70 for kindergarteners, €75 for Grades 1-6, €75 for Grades 7-12. Additional discounts are available for families with multiple children. Please speak with our site manager, Steve Völker, for more information.

WHO CHOOSES WHAT CHILDREN EAT?

Parents choose meals for children up to Grade 4. If you forget, your child automatically receives Menu A. From Grade 5, students may choose meals themselves.

WHEN DO PARENTS RECEIVE THE MONTHLY MEAL PLAN?

Always one month in advance.

Yes. You can block certain groups of food and other items on the student card, e.g. dairy products, soft drinks or ice cream. As a general rule, sweets and soft drinks are only sold to students in Grade 10 or above. A student's grade is shown on the student card.
